Our first indoor service will be held this Sunday, October 11, at 10 a.m. If you are planning on attending, we ask that you continue to follow these guidelines for the safety and comfort of all:

- Enter through the main back doors only. They will be open at 9:30 a.m. sharp. No other doors will be open.
- Masks are required for all attending. If you do not have one, we will provide you with one at the door. Hand sanitizer will be provided.
- Greeters will welcome you. Please sign in, have your temperature taken, and proceed to the sanctuary via the stairs or the elevator. Bathrooms on both floors will be open. Hallways, Fellowship Hall, and other rooms will not.
- Ushers will be outside the sanctuary to safely seat you in a socially distanced manner. Please remain in your pew throughout the service.
- There will be no nursery, Odyssey, or youth programs at this time. Children will sit with their families for the entirety of the service.
- At the close of the service, please remain in your pew. Ushers will safely dismiss everyone.
- Please proceed downstairs and exit the church through the back doors.

We greatly appreciate your patience and support as we move forward following the recommendations of the Michigan Conference and local and state governments. Thank you to all the volunteers who have helped to facilitate a return to indoor worship. Although things will be a bit different, we are blessed to have a church family that works together to make things happen no matter the circumstances!
